

## CAS CHIEF MOUNTAIN BARRELS FUTURITY AND DERBY ENTRY RULES 2020

1. **Futurity** is open to horses that are foals of 2015 or younger (5yrs & under). Horse must never have competed in **any** barrel race (excluding time only or exhibition runs) prior to November 15, 2019  
**Derby** is open to any horses that are foaled 2013-2015 (7yrs & under).  
No cross entries with Futurity
2. **Futurity/Derby**. A photocopy, front and back, of registration papers or a **certified** Veterinarian's Affidavit verifying age of unregistered horse **must** accompany nomination form.
3. There will be 2 go rounds and a short go in the Futurity and Derby  
The top 12 will come back for the short go determined by the fastest 2 times combined.  
To determine the average Champion and average payout the **fastest qualifying time from the 2 go rounds** will be added to the short go.  
Running order will be drawn for 1<sup>st</sup> go and reverse order for 2<sup>nd</sup> go. Short go will be 12<sup>th</sup> to 1<sup>st</sup>
4. Nomination payments are due August 1, 2020 and September 1, 2020. Payments may be made by mailing two post-dated cheques or one cheque in the full amount. Make cheques payable to the Cardston Ag Society. E-transfers are accepted and can be sent to [cardstonag@gmail.com](mailto:cardstonag@gmail.com) using the password **cardston**  
We will also accept payment via **Credit Card**.
5. There will be no refunds for any reason.
6. Any NSF cheque will be subject to a \$50.00 fine.
7. Buyouts or selling of futurity/derby entries **will not** be allowed.
8. Substitutions of horse entry will be allowed for death, illness, or unsoundness. An affidavit of proof from a **certified** Veterinarian must accompany the substitution with a fee of \$25.00. Must be the same owner.
9. Rider substitution is allowed as long as the office is notified prior to the start of the event. There will be no additional fee.
10. There will be no late entries accepted for the futurity or derby after September 15, 2020
11. Dress code – Western attire including long sleeve collared shirt, cowboy boots, cowboy hat or helmet. This is for all the events held during the Chief Mountain Barrels.
12. There will be **self penning allowed only in designated areas** (see entry form for fee) on the event site. Space is limited. A fine of \$50 will be enforced to anyone self penning outside of designated area. You will be responsible for clean up.
13. **Mandatory for All riders** in Futurity and Derby must check in at the office by 8am Saturday September 26. All Futurity and Derby horses may be subjected to an examination to meet registration identifications or examination for age in discretion of Management.  
Any horse examined and found to be of ineligible age, failing to meet registration description will be disqualified.
14. All entrants/owners/competitors will be responsible for themselves and their horses. All futurity and Derby horses entered are subject to examination to meet registration identifications or examination for age. Any horse found to be of ineligible age, failing to meet registration description will be disqualified from competition.
15. Inhumane treatment of horse will not be tolerated and will result in disqualification.
16. All competitors must be ready to compete once their name has been announced or they forfeit their run. A designated time limit will be announced prior to the start of the event.

Completion of entry form or payment of entry fee will indicate acceptance of all rules and regulations governing this event.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein contained it is understood that each contestant/owner and all associated to waives all claims against the CAS Chief Mountain Barrels Futurity, Derby, and Open barrel racing, organizing body, workers, etc. for any injury, or loss of damages which may result in any way from the operations of activities of the Chief Mountain Futurity, Derby and Open Barrel race. Chief Mountain Committee has the right to refuse service to anyone

#### Futurity and Derby Format

25% to 1<sup>st</sup> go, 25% to second go, 10% to short go and 40% to the average

30 or less entries pays 4 monies in each go 2 in the short and 4 in the average

31-60 entries pays 6 monies in each go 4 in the short go and 6 in the average

61-99 entries will pay 8 monies in the go rounds, 6 in the short and 8 in the average

100 plus entries will pay 10 monies in the go rounds 8 in the short go and 10 in the average

2D sidepot will have a 1 second split for each go round of the Futurity and Derby

8am -10am Open riding, no barrel work. \$10 to be paid at the gate.

No leading of horses will be allowed.

10am- -1pm Time onlys \$5/min

1-2pm Open Riding, no barrel work. \$10 pay at gate. No leading of horses will be allowed.

2-6:30pm Time onlys \$5/min.

6:30-7:30pm Arena is closed.

7:30pm Open Barrel Racing Jackpot

##### **Saturday September 26**

5-6 am Open Riding. no barrels \$10 pay at gate No leading of horses will be allowed

6- 10am Time onlys \$5/min. Futurity/Derby horses only

10-11am Arena Closed.

11am 1<sup>st</sup> go of futurity followed by the derby ( 30 min break between the two events )

**\*\*Tentative\*\***4pm -5pm open ride for Open Barrel Jackpot entrants. \$10 paid with entry. No leading of horses allowed.

5-6pm arena closed

6pm Open Jackpot

##### **Sunday September 27**

6-9am Time onlys Futurity and Derby Only. \$5/min

9-10am Arena closed

10am 2<sup>nd</sup> go of futurity followed by Derby (30 min break between two events

There will be a full hour break between the second go and the short round
