



Kickin' Cactus Rules

1. Open, & Youth divisions are determined by a 1 sec split. Peewee will be a 10 sec split
2. Peewee 11 & under as of Jan 1, 2022, Youth 17 and under as of Jan 1, 2022
3. 3D format for Open, youth and peewee
4. All contestants must sign and submit liability waiver with entries
5. The fastest penalty free time in the Open, Youth, and Pee Wee will determine the divisions.
6. Knocked barrels are considered a no time. Once you break the eye and timer has started if you break pattern it is considered a no time.
7. If the timer fails during a run and time is not recorded, the horse and rider shall receive a penalty free re-run.
8. Western attire is mandatory.
9. pay out for each go, prizes awarded to 2 run average winners
10. 90% payout for warm up jp, 100% payout for KC open, youth & PW
11. Payout will be paid as per ABRA recommendations, slot race will pay 4 holes in each D
12. All members are required to read and comply with the rules of the Kickin Cactus.
13. Contestants must be mounted and ready to enter the arena when name called
14. A contestant may ride any horse, regardless of ownership.
15. If any concerns or questions arise, we will refer to ABRA rules to resolve the issue
16. The Following will not be tolerated
 - a. Yelling or any foul language.
 - b. Altercations or quarreling at any time.
 - c. Tampering or removing markers for pattern
 - d. No whipping or disciplining of horse or general inhumane treatment on site
 - e. Non-payment of entry fee
 - f. Leaving ill-mannered horses unsupervised where the safety to other members, horses, property, and/or spectators is at risk
 - g. Any member showing disrespect to a host in any manner, be it foul language, altercations, quarreling, or otherwise.
